LAS VEGAS -- What has six wheels, multiple financial experts and loads of free advice?

The money bus. And it was making its way through the valley Tuesday as part of a nationwide tour. Experts are available with advice on taxes, college planning and investment preparations.

The bus started its tour in January and will wheel into towns from coast to coast until June.

In each city, local financial experts give their time and skills free of charge.

People dealing with bankruptcy -- all kinds of issues with financial statements and portfolios. Really it's just a matter of getting people going back on the right path," said volunteer Greg Phelps of Red Rock Private Wealth Consulting.
